Hydrological Research Letters Collection for Early Career Researchers (CECR) Call for Papers

Hydrological Research Letters (HRL) is an open-access journal published jointly by Japan Society of Hydrology and Water Resources (JSHWR), Japanese Association of Groundwater Hydrology (JAGH), Japanese Association of Hydrological Sciences (JAHS), and Japanese Society of Physical Hydrology (JSPH). HRL is included in the following major databases; Emerging Source Citation Index (ESCI, Web of Science Core Collection), Scopus, Google Scholar Metrics, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ).

HRL calls for young researchers' papers (CECR) as follows. We look forward to many submissions.

Submission period: From Sep 26th through Nov 12th, 2022

Submission conditions: The first or the corresponding author should be under or equal to 40 years old.

Editorial policy: Judgement within 3 months is guaranteed. The judgement will be acceptance, minor revision or rejection. The total number of CECR submissions (Autumn 2019 — Autumn 2021) was 40. Among them, 19 were accepted, 19 were rejected and 2 were withdrawn. Average peer review period of accepted papers was 74 days and that of rejected papers was 28 days.

How to submit: Submit from the following HRL site and select the post category "Collection for Early Career Researchers".

Notice: Authors of CECR have received the "Young Author Excellent Article Awards" from the Japan Society of Hydrology and Water Resources (JSHWR) for their papers published in CECR. To be eligible for this award, you must be a member of JSHWR at the time of publication. Please consider to be a member of JSHWR soon after the acceptance of your paper.
